Conversations and prayer were hard and exhausting. However, both of these people are now in safe places getting continuing care and counsel.

We also had a lot of joy from seeing many high school students at Fall Blast (our regional youth retreat for the Norton Sound) and many young adults at "The Gathering" (our road system retreat). It is awesome to see people move forward in their faith journey.

Tonight I got a call from a high school student in a village in Norton Sound who is struggling with guilt from his physical relationship with his girlfriend. There are so many young people trying to sort it all out, and they are in
